Dear Parents and Carers,

I hope this letter finds you well. I am writing to share the results of our recent pupil survey and to extend our gratitude for your continued support and involvement in our school community.

We are pleased to report that the survey results were very positive, reflecting the hard work and dedication of our staff and the supportive environment we strive to create. The survey highlighted several key strengths and areas for development, which I would like to share with you.

Our top three strengths, as identified by the pupils, are:

1. **Respect and Equality:** 98% of children agreed that our school encourages them to respect people from other backgrounds and to treat everyone equally.
2. **Emotional Support:** 96% of children feel they have someone to talk to at school when they feel sad or worried.
3. **Mental Health Awareness:** 95% of children believe the school encourages them to look after their emotional and mental health.


However, the survey also highlighted some areas where we can improve:

4. **Challenging Work:** Only 33% of children agreed that adults give them work that challenges them.
5. **Representation in Lessons:** 35% of children feel they see, hear, or learn about people like them in their lessons.
6. **Opportunities for Improvement:** 51% of children feel they get a chance to work on what they need to improve once they find out.

We are committed to addressing these areas and have already started planning staff CPD sessions to ensure we can better meet the needs of our pupils. Your feedback and the voices of our children are invaluable in helping us create a nurturing and effective learning environment.

Thank you once again for your support and for encouraging your children to participate in the survey. Together, we can continue to make our school a place where every child can thrive.
