

<p>Science</p> <p><u>Plants:</u> Pupils will study plants, learning about their parts and functions, what they need to grow, how water is transported, and how plants reproduce and disperse seeds, alongside carrying out investigations and interpreting data.</p> <p><u>Light</u> Children will identify sources of light. They will describe materials that are opaque, transparent and translucent; describe what shadows are and how they are formed and find the pattern between the length of a shadow and the position of the light source.</p>	<p>Geography</p> <p><u>Weather and Climate:</u> Children will learn about weather and climate, including how weather is measured, why the UK's weather can change so often, and how climates differ around the world. We will also be looking at climate change and extreme weather.</p>	<p>Geography</p> <p><u>Looking at Mountains</u> The unit teaches how mountains are formed and how this links to their location on Earth, followed by taking a look at a mountainous climate which makes links back to their previous Geography unit.
